Overview

As part of a cooperation agreement between Italian Ministry of Environment and Energy Security and ISPRA (the Italian National Institute for Environmental Protection and Research) on Seveso-related activities, a program of events aimed at facilitating the exchange of experiences among Member States is foreseen.

In light of the outcomes of the previous event, which addressed industrial risk in areas with a high concentration of Seveso establishments, the present conference will focus on “**inspections and controls in establishments subjected to both Seveso and Industrial Emissions (IED) EU Directives**”. The conference will provide an opportunity to promote comparison and harmonization of the regulatory frameworks and to discuss possible approaches for coordinating inspection activities.

Particular attention will be given to the role of national and international authorities, as well as on the exchange of experiences among all relevant stakeholders, with the objective of applying the principles of simplification and ensuring a uniform implementation of the regulatory framework at European level.

The event is open to the participation from others Member States, with the aim of promoting multilateral initiatives, and it will include the participation of Italian local and central authorities which are involved in Seveso and Industrial Emission Directives implementation.
